Beginning on a Red oak near the Saluda Gap road, running thence N. 20 W. 31. to a pine. N. 35 E. N. 25 E. to a pine. S. 10 E. S. 12 East to a pine thence S. 68 W. to the Beginning corner containing one hundred and fourteen acres it being part of a tract of land M. Rush bought of the Cities - Together with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining. To Have and To hold to the said James Hill Jr his heirs and assigns forever - I do hereby warrant and forever defend the right thereof to him his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs or assigns, or any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
