To all to whom these presents shall come, I David Hoke Coroner pro tem of Greenville District & State

aforsaid, send greeting: Whereas by virtue of writs of fieri facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested the thirtieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred forty at the suit of Peter Couble and return to me directed commanding me that of the goods & chattels, lands and tenements of David Hemming to buy the sum of six thousand three hundred and seventy dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said David Hemming all that certain piece, parcel, and tract of land containing one & one fourth acres more or less situate and being in the District of Greenville on the waters of Richland Creek adjoining lands of William Choice and the Janyard tract, upon which is situated a kitchen & smoke house formerly occupied by the said Hemming while in possession of the Janyard and which he purchased of William Choice and whereas the said premises with their appurtenances were seized by virtue of writs of fieri facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public auction and purchased by Edmund Waddill of the District of Greenville for the sum of three hundred forty dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor. Now know ye, that I David Hoke Coroner pro tem aforsaid by virtue of the said writs of fieri facias aforsaid to me directed & delivered as aforsaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said sum of three hundred and forty dollars, to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Edmund Waddill the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Edmund Waddill his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances
