Know all men by these presents that I, William Robinson of the District of Anderson for and in consideration of sixteen hundred and eighty five Dollars to me in hand paid by Mrs Elizabeth R. Earle of the District of Greenville State aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents I do hereby sell, bargain to and deliver unto the said Elizabeth R. Earle seven Negroes, to wit, Charity a woman about thirty years of age, and Adeline her child about eleven years of age, Laura, nine years of age, Adam, six years of age, Henry about four years of age, Jane about two years of age, and Louiza, an infant, all of the last named six, being the children of the above named Charity. To have and to hold, the said above named seven negroes, unto the said Elizabeth R. Earle, her heirs and assigns forever, and I, do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors, my administrators and assigns, to warrant and defend the title unto the said seven negroes, unto the said Mrs E. R. Earle, and also that they are slaves for life, against me and my heirs, executors and administrators, and against every person claiming or to claim the same Given under my hand and seal this 24th day of December A. D. 1842
