Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said piece of land belonging or appertaining. To have and to hold the premises before mentioned unto the said John W Harrison and his heirs forever against myself and my heirs and against all and singular the heirs of my late husband Dr Richard Harrison and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming the said piece of land or any part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal at Greenville Court House the Eleventh day of December A. D. 1843

Know all men by these presents that I Silas Bruce of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Walker Morgan of the District and State aforesaid have bargained granted sold and released and by these presents do bargain grant sell and release unto the said Walker Morgan all that tract or parcel of land whereon I now live containing One hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less situate in the District and State aforesaid on a branch of Thompsons Beaverdam Creek waters of middle Tyger River bounded on the east by Robert Fergusons land North by Hadden Brucers
