In obedience to an act of Congress prescribing the mode of naturalization the undersigned Hugh M Govern reports to the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville District South Carolina that he was born in the County of Latham Province of Connaught Ireland, in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and ninety eight that he sailed for the United States on the tenth day of May Eighteen hundred and twenty nine and landed first at Quebec in the month of July of the same year from whence he sailed on the twenty sixth of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty and landed at the City of New York in the same month and that he has resided in South Carolina six years sworn to and subscribed the first day of July 1843
