of Greenville District and State of South Carolina do hereby give the said send Greeting; Whereas by virtue of sundry writs of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville one tested the first day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty one at the suit of Surpin & Powers. to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of Thomas Meadows to levy the sum of Forty two Dollars and by seven cents damages and costs. I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Thomas Meadows all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land containing more or less three hundred and thirteen acres situate and being in the District of Greenville on the waters of Ennoree River where Defendant now lives adjoining lands of Curtis Bradley Mar Edwards and others And whereas the said premises with the appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writs of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at Public vendue and purchased by Roger Loveland of the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina for the sum of Two hundred and five Dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor Now know ye that William M Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the writs of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of Two hundred and five Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Roger Loveland the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Roger Loveland his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of Land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Thomas Meadows had of right of in and to the same. To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of Land with its appurtenances unto the said Roger Loveland his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said W M Goodlett Sheriff as aforesaid might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid or of the said writs of Fieri Facias or otherwise.
