 Bailey Social. Helgare Administrator the last mentioned ne-
 gro I reserve the right to sell if found expedient by me
 for the benefit of my said daughter and the heirs of her
 body the aforesaid negroes with their increase I loan to my
 daughter Mary P Rowley during her natural life
 but with no right to sell or transfer or contract debts
 on the faith of said negroes as her property but to be and
 remain in her possession during her life and at the time
 of her death she having children heirs of her body then
 and in that case I convey the right of the aforesaid negroes
 with their increase equally to her children to them and their
 heirs or assigns forever Provided nevertheless in the event
 of her dying not leaving living children as before described
 then and in that case the aforesaid negroes and their
 increase is to be equally divided between her surviving
 brothers and sisters or their children as the case may
 be who are vested with full power by this deed to sue and
 recover the same in any court of Law or equity in this
 State or the United States. In witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty
 seventh day of September in the year of our Lord One
 thousand eight hundred and forty three. Signed sealed
