

Solomon Loftis, Deed of Sale for 50 Acres Land 291

For James Loftis. State of South Carolina.
 Know all men by these presents that I, Solomon Loftis, of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of One Hundred Dollars to me paid by James Loftis of the State and District above mentioned said Solomon Loftis have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Loftis a plantation or tract of Land lying in Greenville District on Fox Creek of South Sugar River, containing fifty acres, more or less it being a part of a tract of Land granted to Archibald Dill, and by said Dill conveyed to James Copeland from Copeland to Benjamin West, from said West to William Harbrow, and from Harbrow to me, the said fifty acres beginning on a post oak running 60 ch. N. 45 ch. to a chestnut corner thence a conditional line between Gorin and Copeland to a post oak corner agreed on by themselves, thence straight across the Creek to a chestnut agreed on thence down the Creek to the mouth of the branch that heads up by the old school house, thence up the said hauck to where it crosses thence to the beginning corner, being fifty acres, more or less, together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said James Loftis his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Loftis his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
