Know all men by these presents, that I, Levi Potts, of the one part in consideration of the sum of one hundred to me paid in hand by Hiram Dill of the other part both in the State and District aforesaid, having entered, bargained, sold and delivered and released unto the said Hiram Dill all and singular a Plantation or tract of Land containing eighty-five acres, be the same more or less situated in the said district on oil Camp Creek, bounded on the West by John Wilkerson's Land and on the East by John Gilliant's Land beginning at a large spruce pine on the No. side of the Creek thence to a large rock called the bare house from thence to a white walnut station, thence up the middle of said ridge to the north line of the original survey thence N. 65 East to a pine S. & W. 24 91 links to a stake 25 West to a Gum 57 West x 23 to a certain ridge to a poplar 3 x at the head of a branch thence down said branch to the middle of the Creek Maple 3 x thence down the middle of said Creek to the beginning together with all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Hiram Dill his heirs, assigns, and I do bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend the above mentioned tract of Land unto the said Hiram Dill his heirs or assigns, being the same 85 acres more or less, Given under my hand and seal this 19 of January, 1844.
