 We, M. B. Earle and C. P. Earle, Executors of the Estate of Thos
 Earle, deceased, by the authority delegated to us in his last Will and
 Testament, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum
 of Three hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid by The Protestant
 Episcopal Church of Christ Church, Greenville, in the State aforesaid
 Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said Protestant Episcopal Church of
 Christ Church, Greenville, and the successors thereof, All that tract or
 lot of Land situate lying and being within the corporate limits of
 the Village of Greenville, the District aforesaid, Bounded on the North
 East by the road leading out of said Village to Spartanburg and
 Laurens Court Houses, running from the beginning corner on said
 road with Waddy Thompson's line - So. 20 E. 82. Dls. 10 lks to a Post
 Oak corner thence North 75 W. to where it touches the land belonging
 to the Episcopal Church - thence with the church line back to the
 said Road thence with said Road to the beginning corner. Con-
 Taining one Acre, two rods and thirty-eight perches as more plain-
 ly appears by a plat hereto annexed dated April 2nd 1836, and
 surveyed by John C. Hunt having such shape and marks as are re-
 presented thereon. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members,
 Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or
 in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and
 singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Protestant Epis-
 copal Church of Christ Church Greenville and their successors
 and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs,
 Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all
 and singular the said Premises, unto the said Protestant Episcopal
 Church of Christ Church, Greenville, and their successors and assigns,
 against ourselves and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever,
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness,
 we hand and seal, this eighteenth day of April in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-two and in the sixty-
 sixth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
