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Know all men by these presents that I, Thomas Smith of the State and District aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by John D. Smith of the State and District aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John D. Smith a certain Plantation or tract of land containing sixty acres more or less lying in the district and State aforesaid, on the South side of Rocky Creek of Emory River, lines and boundaries as follows: Beginning at the said Rocky Creek on the north bank of said Creek in a Street Corner of J. W. Hudsons and thence across the said Creek along James Watsons line to a chestnut corner down near a branch thence running a direct and straight line to James Watsons red oak corner thence along the said Watsons line to a branch of Rocky Creek thence down the said branch to Rocky Creek then up the said Creek to the beginning. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Appurtenances and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said J. D. Smith, his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said J. D.
