Know all men by these presents that I, Ephraim Lyles of the State and District aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty-four Dollars and Fifty Cents to me in hand paid by John D. Smith of the State and District aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John D. Smith a certain tract or parcel of Land, being part of a tract formerly owned by Yacharial Smith, containing forty-one Acres and a half, be the same more or less, situated in the State and District aforesaid, on branches of Quashy Creek, waters of Ennee River, beginning on a Hickory ^{tree} ~~tree~~ thence N. 4° W. 30 chains to a red oak sapling ^{tree} ~~tree~~ on thence S. 75° E. 12.50 chains to a Rock corner ^{tree} ~~tree~~ thence S. 3° E. 26.50 chains to stake ^{tree} ~~tree~~ thence S. 12° E. 12.25 chains to a Hickory ^{tree} ~~tree~~ thence N. 50° W. 15.80 chains to the beginning Hickory. Together with all and singular the rights, members, appurtenances and appertinances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John D. Smith, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said John D. Smith his heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this thirteenth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-one and in the sixty-sixth year of the American Independence.
