


Daniel Harrison

Deed for 134 Acres.

State of South Carolina.

Known all men by these presents that
 I, Daniel Harrison of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and thirty seven dollars and fifty cents to me paid by Henry Dodd have granted, bargained, sold, released and conveyed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said Henry Dodd all that certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the north side of Vaughan's Creek of north Paulet River, being the same tract that was sold by the Sheriff of Greenville district and State aforesaid, as the property of James Fisher, and deeded to Henry Dodd, containing One hundred and thirty-four Acres, more or less, beginning at a red oak and runs thence S. 60 E. 18 chains to a stake S x thence S. 35 chains to a stake thence N. 41. W. 50 chains to a stake thence N. 20 W. 23 chains to a stake thence S. 56 E. 35 chains and 50 links to the beginning corner, to have and to hold the premises above described with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to the said Henry Dodd his heirs and assigns forever, and I do bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators and assigns, to warrant and forever defend the rights of the above mentioned premises, to the said Henry Dodd his heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, and no other person or persons claiming the said premises or any part thereof. The condition of the within Deed is such, that if the said Daniel Harrison pays or cause to be paid to the said Henry Dodd his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, the sum of Three Hundred and Thirty-seven ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars to be paid as follows: One hundred 25th December next, One hundred the 25th December, 1845, and one hundred and thirty-seven ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars 25th Dec 1846, bearing interest from the 25th Dec, 1845, then this Deed to be null and void or otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
