Together with all and singular the Quitclaiments, Rights, Members and Appurtenances whatsoever, to the said Tract of land belonging, or in any wise appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James H. Cleveland his Heirs and Assigns forever, in as full and ample manner as the said State of South Carolina hold and enjoy the same.

This Indenture, made the seventeenth day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, between John H. Leland, Superintendent of Public Works of the State aforesaid, of the one part, and James H. Cleveland of the other part.

Whereas, The General Assembly of the State aforesaid, on the nineteenth day of December, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, ratified an Act entitled "An Act to authorize the Superintendent of Public Works to dispose of certain lands belonging to the
