

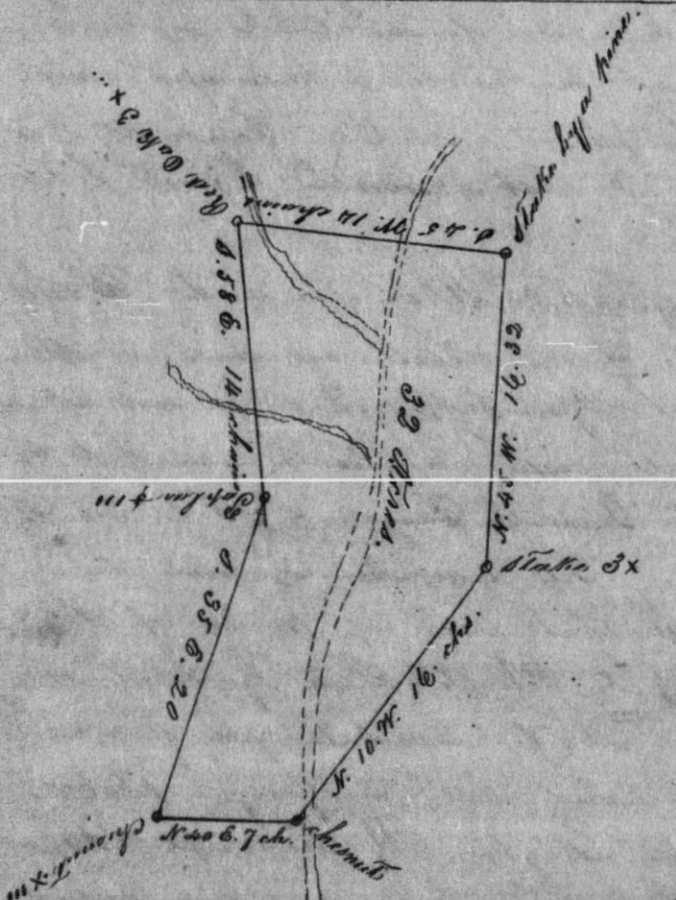

Know all men by these pre-
sents, that I, Isaac Lemmons,
of Greenville District, of the State aforesaid, in consideration of
Twenty-four Dollars to me paid by John Cox, Sr. of Greenville District, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said John Cox, Sr. all that plantation or tract of Land situate,
lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the waters of
the North fork of Saluda River, containing thirty-two Acres be the same more
or less, and has such shape, marks, buttings and boundaries as the plat
herunto annexed represents and to which reference must be had for a
more particular description. Together with all and singular the rights, Members,
Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said John Cox his Heirs and assigns
forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my
Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the
said premises unto the said John Cox, his
Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my
Heirs, and against every other person whom-
soever lawfully claiming the same or any
part thereof.
