E. to Black oak on the Beaufort Road No N. to a hickory thence N. 45 E. 37 1/2 to a red oak thence with Mitchels to the road thence along sd road to a state thence a conditional line to a state thence along Morris line to a post oak thence along Widow Loftis line to the beginning corner containing two hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the sd premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the sd Dennis Crane his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, my Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the sd premises unto the sd Dennis Crane his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this 19th of November, Eighteen hundred forty-one in the sixty-seventh year of the independence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in the presents of us
