Stokes of Greenville District and State aforesaid - I have granted, bargained sold and released - and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto John S. Stokes a certain Tract or parcel of Land whereon Doctor Shelton once lived lying and being situate in Greenville District and State aforesaid, on the waters of Laurel Creek of Waddy River - Beginning on John Goodwins line, thence by John Stokes line, thence by James Seabans line, thence by Wm. Wilsons line, thence by the Widow Sheltons line, thence to the beginning corner on John Stokes line - containing Two Hundred Acres more or less, together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident - To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John S. Stokes his Heirs and Assigns, and I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, administrators & Assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John S. Stokes his Heirs and Assigns against myself my Heirs and Assigns, and against any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
