Bellew and Reuben Bellew beginning on Achesnut oak near the Jones
Camp road stone North a straight line line to the back line near
the creek thence with the old line on the west as the original sur-
vey runs to the Beginning containing by estimation one hundred and
thirty acres be the same more or less Being a part of tract of
Land granted to Richard Ward and conveyed to Jacob Bellew
sen^r together with all and singular the rights, members his adittments
and appurtenances belonging to the same at incident thereto to have
