whatsoever, especially, my Dever, in a certain tract of land, con-
taining Three Hundred acres, (more or less) in Greenville District,
South Carolina, situate, lying and being, in the waters of Fork Shoal
Creek, being waters of Reedy River, and adjoining lands of Edwin Ware,
Sam'l Moore, & others, on which David Berry my Deceased husband for-
merly lived, and which was sold at Sheriff's sale as his property, &
purchased by Tully Bolling; giving and granting, unto my said Attor-
ney by these presents, my full and whole power, strength, and authority,
in the said premises, to have, use, and take, all lawful ways, and
means, in my name; for the purpose of recovering all my right, ti-
