Tyege River & bounded by lands of Mrs Cunningham South Et. & Sur. Wm. Edwards & others To have and to hold all & singular all our right title claim & interest in the above premises, to them, and their heirs and assigns forever, to have & to hold the said tract of land - We do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Et Administrators and assigns never to set up any claim to the sd tract of land be the same more or less This Given under our hands and seals this 19th of January Eighteen hundred and forty two.
