Know all men by these presents
that I, Andrew Bridges of
the State and district above written for and in consideration of the
sum of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid
by Jeremiah Cleveland of the same place have granted bargain-
ed sold and released and by these presents do grant bar-
gain sell and release unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland all
that Tract or parcel of Land whereon I now live situated
in the District and State aforesaid on Duncan Branch waters
of Kedy River containing Two Hundred and Twenty five acres
be the same more or less being part of a tract of Land
originally granted to Scobias Langston the 3rd day of April
1786, and part of another tract believed to be originally grant-
ed to said Langston and Robt. Duncan the 1st day of August
1785, and conveyed by them to Harder Camp and by said Camp,
& Duncan to David Brock and by the said David Brock part
to me and part to Joshua Hawkins then from said Hawkins
to me, Beginning at a Pine corner being said Brock's and Robt
Duncan's corner. Thence N. 60 W. 35 C. & 50 links to a large
felled red oak Robt Duncan's old corner. Thence N. 78 W.
9 ch. 75 links to a post oak in a field Thence N. 5 E. 32
ch. to a black oak old corner. Thence N. 66 E. 15 ch. 50 links
to a stake Thence N. 80 E. 9 ch. 25 links to a maple
& h. wood stake, on the bank of the branch Thence up
the meanders of the branch keeping the right hand going
to a dead dead oak corner known as Hubblays corner,
Thence along Hubblays line S. 69 E. 29 ch. to a Hickory
Brock's corner Thence S. about 20 W. 69 chs. to to the
