Articles of Agreement.

South Carolina Articles of agreement between William Erisham of the one part and Hugh P. McClinton, John P. McClinton,

Hawkins, & Elizabeth Smith, wife of Natho Smith of the other part, Witnesseth That whereas Jane McClinton now the wife of the said William Erisham was seized & possessed of a Tract of land and considerable other Property at the time of her marriage with the said Wm Erisham Now I the said Wm Erisham for and in consideration of one dollar have granted, bargained, sold & released & by these presents do will release and quit claim to the said Hugh P. McClinton, John P. McClinton and their Sisters Sarah Nancy & Elizabeth to them and their heirs forever after the death of their Mother Jane Erisham all that Tract of land in which the said Jane Erisham now resides containing 267 acres (except a few acres sold to P. T. & J. L. Fowler) Situate in Spartanburg District, beginning at a stake on said line of run S. 86 chs to a P. C. 3 x E. 31 chs to a stone 3 x N. 34 chs to a P. C. 3 x E. 4.50 to a Stone N. 52 chs. to a Stake N. 35.50 to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and to hold the said Land unto the said Hugh P. McClinton, & others aforesaid, their heirs and assigns after the death of their mother Jane Erisham, from me and my heirs and every other person claiming by or through me, and I the said William Erisham do will and release & quit all my claim to the said Hugh P. McClinton & others above named (after the death of the said Jane McClinton) or our two negro woman named Cit & her son Jemier and their increase also
