 fully pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said James S. Suignard, the sum  
 of fifteen Hundred Dollars, with interest thereon from the first day of  
 December instant according to the tenor and effect of the three Notes  
 above mentioned, then and from thenceforth, these presents shall be ut-  
 terly null and void; any thing herein contained to the contrary there-  
 of in any wise notwithstanding. And it is covenanted and agreed  
 upon, by and between the parties to these presents, that until default  
 shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth  
 and the interest for the same, it shall and may be lawful to and  
 for the said Whiteford Smith peaceably and quietly to hold, use,  
 occupy, possess and enjoy, all and singular the premises above gran-  
 ted, and released, and every part thereof with the appurte-  
 nances, and to have, receive and take the rents, issues and pro-  
 fits thereof to his own particular use and behoof; any thing  
 herein contained to the contrary hereof in any wise notwith-  
 standing.
