

Lankford of the same state and district all my interest in certain tract or parcels of Land (it being one half of said tract conveyed to myself and Natham W. Lankford by Lewis H. Edwards) situate in the state and District above named on both sides of Mottlys Creek waters of South Carolina River Beginning in a black oak on the south side of said creek Running thence N 14 W 84 chains crossing said creek to a pine thence south 73° E 23 chains crossing a branch to a post oak thence S W E 75 chains to a black oak thence S 61 E 15 chains to the beginning containing one hundred and thirty five acres be the same more or less to have and to hold all and singular the rights titles hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining) and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators for ever to warrant and defend the above sd interest in said land unto the said Minor C. Lankford his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs and assigns and against the lawful claim of all other persons claiming the same or any part thereof.
