Hollyclaw conveyed to Edwards by Edmund Waddill Beginning at a Maple on a branch known by the name of Hollands Spring branch running S. 79 W 16 55 chs to white oak 3 x on the bank of the river thence down the meanders of the river to the mouth of said Spring branch thence up the meanders of said branch to the beginning Maple reference to plat made by Washington Taylor will more fully appear Containing Thirty two acres Together with all and singular the rights, Members Hereditaments and appertinances to said Premises belonging or in any wise incident and appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the before mentioned premises unto the said Taylor his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Taylor his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
