South Carolina in consideration of the sum of Fifty five Dollars to me paid by Daniel Cockburn of Greenville District & state aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Daniel Cockburn all that tract or parcel of land being the same tract whereon the said Daniel Cockburn now lives, being part of a tract of land originally granted to James West, and deeded by said James West to Henshick Cockburn conveyed from Henshick Cockburn to Daniel Cockburn by deed of gift lying on the south side of Ruddy fork waters of Ruddy River Beginning on a stake in the original line in a marked corner of a piece of land deeded to John Garden Running from thence down the marsh to where it intersects a Branch that runs from Isaac Robbards Spring thence down the branch to the creek thence down the creek until a certain white oak will be in a line with the next corner a person may see the back of said Daniel Cockburns Smoke house, thence to the Beginning containing fifty acres more or less Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the Premises before mentioned, unto the said Daniel Cock-
