Know, all men by these Presents, That we George F. Townes & Elizabeth A. Townes of Greenville District in the aforesaid State, in consideration of Eight

Hundred Dollars to us paid by P. F. Peny of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents, do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said P. F. Peny all that Lot or parcel of land situate lying and being in the Village of Greenville on the Square south of the Court House & East side of Main Street, Beginning at a Stake corner on Main Street on the upper end of P. F. Peny's lot on which his House stands, thence up said street N 17^{1/2} E 89^{1/2} feet to a stake on said street opposite the upper corner of Peny's office chimney - thence S. 73^{1/2} E. 119^{1/2} feet to a stake on Towns Garden fence - thence S. 17^{1/2} W. 30^{3/4} feet to a stake & thence S. 72^{1/2} E. 328 feet to a stake on Sull Street - thence down Sull Street S. 17^{1/2} W. 58^{3/4} feet to a stake on Peny's Lot - thence N. 72^{1/2} W. 35^{1/2} feet to the beginning corner on Main Street, including Peny's Law offices the Plat of John Watson fully describes.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Creditments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said P.
