

Together with all and singular the rights members foundations and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said W^m G. Vance his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W^m G. Vance his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
