

September Anne Demore 1844 - Daniel Jenkins and Francis L. Ross Esquires are directed and required to sell certain Tracts of Land in Greenwell District purchased from Howell & M<sup>r</sup> Alister called Chestnut Hill - and the Household and Kitchen Furniture - and the stocks of Cattle thereon - and the following thirty six negroes, viz Sharpes, Andrew, Abraham, Jeffry and his Wife Hagar - and their children Peter little Jeffry, Sylvia, Lander, Harry, Christiana, Mentha & Margaret, Bob, John, Kate Francis, Jemima Celia James, Joseph, Jeremiah and Anne, Benah & her few children, Flora, Sam, Jane, and Renah & Juno & her seven children, Hector Quatrain, Rosa Jane Jacob Casant & Toby and Marsh - and whereas the said Daniel Jenkins & Francis L. Ross have been commanded by Process of the Honorable the Court of Equity for the District aforesaid forthwith to sell the aforesaid property and apply the proceeds in the manner directed & appointed by the said appointments of the said Mrs. S. Baker aforesaid -

Now Know all men by these presents that I, Daniel Jenkins of the Town of Beaufort have made & constituted Benjamin F. Perry Esquire of Greenwell - and by these presents do make and constitute the said Benjamin F. Perry my sufficient and lawful attorney for me and in my name - alone, or in conjunction with the said Francis L. Ross or his lawful attorney to bargain sell grant release and convey to such person or persons and for such sum or sums of money as to my attorney shall seem proper, all or any part of the said Lands in Greenwell called Chestnut Hill and upon such sales convenient and proper deeds with such covenants or covenants as to my said attorney shall seem expedient in due form of Law as my Deed or deeds to make seal deliver and acknowledge - and for me in my name, alone, or conjointly with the said Francis L. Ross or his lawfull attorney to sell transfer and deliver, unto any Person or persons whatsoever, and for such price or prices as my said attorney shall think fit, all or any of the Household & Kitchen furniture, in the Houses on the said Lands in Greenwell - and all or any of the stock of cattle thereon - and all or any of the above named thirty six negroes & their increase, which may be in the said Village or District of Greenwell - and for me & in my name to make and pass all necessary assignments, and bills of sale - and for me and in my name to accept & receive all and every the sum or sums of money which shall be coming to me in account of the Sale of the said Lands - and negroes & other personal property - and upon the receipt thereof, suitable receipts or acquittances in my name & deed to make, seal & deliver - and generally giving to my said attorney full power & authority touching the premises, to do, execute, proceed finish and conclude in all things in as ample a manner as I might do if present personally
