


1835 thence down said Creek Intire made by Station to the Mill Pond thence up said Pond to John Pooler line thence across said Pond to a Dogwood thence to a small Red Oak thence N. 2 W. 7. 70, to a Chestnut thence E. 2. 30 ch. to a Post Oak stump or Black Jack thence S. 10 E. 21. 50 to a pine thence S. 25 E. 45 ch. to a Black Oak thence S. 20 W. 24. 50 to a pine or stake thence N. 20, W. 6, 25, to a Hickory thence due West to the Emoree River thence up the various Meanders of said River along the mouth of a ditch thence across said River to the beginning Including all High Water Marks, Containing by Estimation 654 acres.

With all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the Same belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the Premises above mentioned unto the said P. Perrow his Heirs & assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my Heir Executors Administrators or Assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said P. Perrow his Heirs or assigns against myself my Heir and assigns and against every other Person or Persons lawfully claiming or to claim the Same or any part thereof.
