

District in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand nine Hundred and ninety seven Dollars and fifty Cents to us paid by Thomas S. Arthur of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Thomas S. Arthur all that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being on Bush Creek in Greenville District, it being the tract of land conveyed by Ming Hall to Aaron Payne, by a deed dated 31st December 1842, bounded as follows viz: beginning at a P.C. near Bush Creek 3 x 0 m running N 10 E. 12 to a P.C. 3 x 3 x 0 m, thence N 81 E. 31 ch. to a P.C. struck 3 x 0 m thence N. 40 E. 2.50 to a stake 3 x m. thence S. 35 E. crossing Bush Creek 40 ch. to a P.C. 3 x 0 m, 3 x m. m. Mrs. James Carter, thence S 54 W.
