

 Greenville District. } By these pres-
 ents that I Wesley Phillips of the dis-
 trict and State aforesaid for and in

consideration of the sum of Six hundred and fifty dollars to me
 paid by my son-in-law George W. McCarell of the same state
 and district, and also for the love and kindness I have for
 him my said son-in-law, have granted bargained sold and
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and
 release, unto the said George W. McCarell a certain tract of
 land containing four hundred and ninety five acres, more
 or less, situate in said district on Reedy river and the
 waters of Saluda River and hath such bounds, marks
 &c. as follows viz: Beginning at a stake 3x on the East bank
 of Reedy River thence across said river S 72 1/2 W. 56.50 chs.
 to a Post oak 3x thence N 64 1/2 W. 29 chs. to a Post oak
 3x thence S 3 E. 7.50 chs. to a stake 3x thence S 86 W. 29.
 50 chs. to a stake 3x thence S 5 W. 10.50 to a stake 3x
 thence S 77 E. 22.50 chs. to a stake 3x thence due South
 14 1/2 chs. to a Pine 3x thence S 50 W. 11 chs. to a Large
 Black Oak 3x thence S 9 E. 38.50 chs. to a Pine Stump
