Rice all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and sixty two acres, (more or less) situate and lying in the State & District aforesaid on the head branches of Horse Creek waters of Reedy River whereon said Davenport now has - adjoining land of William Anderson on the South, Maj. M. Perry on the North and East - Widener Poling on the West, and J. Moore on the N.E. Beginning on a Sweet Gum & x near said Creek Thence N. 85° W. 35.50 to a Stake or Rock along Wm Anderson's line, thence N. 60° E. 54 chs. across said Creek to a Stone & x, Thence S. 70° E. 35.11 to Sweet Gum & x on J. Moore's line Thence S. 1/2 W. 58 1/2 to the beginning corner - Together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the said premises unto the said William P. Rice his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said W.
