do grant bargain sell and release unto the said R. P. Goodlett
& J. G. Harris Deacons as aforesaid and to their successors in of-
fice & to the survivor, of their successors in office & to the Executor
& administrator of the Survivor for the uses & purposes herein after
named all that Lot or Tract of Land lying in the District of
Greenville & State aforesaid on the waters of Wash Packolett Riv-
er containing five acres more or less beginning at a Turkey
oak Corner and Running N 84 E. 5 Chains to a Rock Corner,
thence N 64 W. 10 ch. to a Rock Corner, thence S 84 W. 5 ch. to a
Rock Corner, thence S 6 E. 10 ch. to the beginning, bounded by
Lands of the said William Walker & John Sanford a more full
description of said Lot will appear by reference to a plat made
by J. M. Dickey 20th July 1847, and which is hereto annexed,
together with all and singular the rights, members and heredita-
ments and appertinances to the said premises belonging, or in any
wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and sin-
gular the premises before mentioned unto the said R. P. Goodlett
and J. G. Harris Deacons of the Cross Roads Baptist Church
as aforesaid, & to their successors in office and to the survivor of
their successors in office & to the Executor or Executors Admin-
istrator or Administrators of the Survivor, In trust always for
the use and benefit of the Cross Roads Baptist Church, and
their successors so long as they continue a body of worshipping
Christians according to the faith of the Baptist denomination.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and
administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular the
said premises unto the said R. P. Goodlett & J. G. Harris Dea-
cons as aforesaid & their successors in office, and to the survivor
of their successors in office & to the Exor or Exor. admr or admr of
the Survivor for the uses & purposes above mentioned and no
other, against me and my heirs and every other person lawfully
claiming the same or any part thereof.
