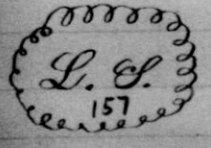

Young of Tishamingo County and State of Mississippi my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name and for my use to ask, demand, sue for, recover, and receive of and from the Executor or Executors, administrator or administrators of the said Estates of William and Mary Young or the separate estate of either of them or from any person or persons, soever, in whose hands the same may be, Confided, my portion of the said Estate whether consisting in Lands, or tenements money debts, goods, wares, and demands of whatever character, for or in account of my full share - Part or dividend of the estate aforesaid - Giving and granting unto my said attorney, by these presents full and whole power, strength and authority in and about the premises to have use and take all lawful ways and means in my name - for the purposes aforesaid and upon the receipt of any such debts dues or sums of money - or property of whatever character (as the case may be) acquittances or other sufficient discharges - for me or in my name to make seal and deliver - And furthermore I hereby authorize my said attorney to appoint one or more legal attorneys which may be of record vesting in said attorneys which my said attorney may appoint all powers necessary to sue for recover and receive all such claims which my said attorney could receive - but under the authority of my attorney in fact -

Hereby ratifying and affirming all and singular the acts of my said attorney or those under him whom he may appoint, which may be done - or performed in and concerning the premises aforesaid.
