Know all men by these presents that I Martin Stone of Greenville District and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Jesse French of the same place, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Jesse French all that plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred and sixteen acres, (more or less) situate and lying in the State and district aforesaid bounded on the North by lands belonging to Joseph McCullough, Rebecca Stone and John Cooley, on the West by Saluda River, on the South by Galas Jordan and the said Jesse French, and on the East by Mountain Creek.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, indentments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Jesse French his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jesse French his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this the Fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight
