Moutrey on the 5th Day of June 1785 the Land to be Conveyed beginning on a post oke by the side of the mile Road Ely Pollards Corner thence Running S 64¹/₂ E 27 ch to a pine formerly a black jack thence Running South West 35 ch 50 links to a pine corner thence Westwardly along George Crofts Line to a Stone Corner near his fence thence North West on Crofts Line to a Red cappel thence South West on Crofts Line to a Red oke thence West on Crofts line to a maple joining John J. Mayfield on the Branch thence up the Branch on Mayfields line to the Road to a Rock on the fork shole Road thence running North east wardly to a Large Spanish oak on the meeting House Road thence Running Eastwardly down to the beginning Corner all so hit being a part of a tract of Land Granted to to Robert Gilliland including one hundred and nine acres of land more or less appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John S.
