 in consideration of the sum of One Thousand dollars
 to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to S. M. Curston of
 the State and District aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, released, and confirmed
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell release convey and confirm unto the
 said S. M. Curston and his heirs a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the
 mentioned District on the Needy Fork of Needy River, adjoining the lands of S.
 M. Curston and others, and containing Two Hundred and Sixty Six Acres be the
 land more or less, and laid out to the said S. M. Curston his Heirs &c by

Beginning on a Chestnut and running S. 40° W 19 chains to a red oak, Thence
 N 33° W 9 chains 50 links to a Hickory sapling, Thence S. 40° W 35 chains to a stake,
 Thence S. E. to the Georgia road to a Stake corner, Thence N. W. to a Red oak
 Thence W 70° E 40 chs 50 links to a Black Gum, Thence N. 20° W 24 chs 50 links to
 a Post Oak, Thence S. 70° W 46 chs 50 links to the Beginning containing Two
 Hundred and Sixty Six Acres more or less including the plantation whereon
 Lewis Nabors formerly lived
