the consideration of One Hundred and eighty seven dollars and fifty cents to me
paid by Thomas Mc Cely of the same place, have granted, bargained, sold and released
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas Mc Cely my part
of a certain tract of land situated in the State & District aforesaid on the waters of Saluda
River containing One Hundred and thirty eight and half acres more or less it being a
tract of land conveyed by Perry Hawkins to the said William Mc Cely & Thomas W
Cely Beginning at a dead Hickory on the branch running thence N 3 E W 17.45 to a
red oak thence S 70 W 6 to a dead red oak near the road, thence S. 96. W 12.90 to a
red oak thence N 45 1/2 W 16.90 to a rock S. Fairs corner, thence S 30 W 15.25 to a dead
oak on the old line thence S. 45 1/2 E 20.50 to a white oak, thence S. 82 E 15.34 to a small pine
thence S 50 1/2 E 12.80 to a rock, thence S 2. E 8.19 to a small red oak, thence S 45 1/2 E 8.50
to a red oak thence S. 84 1/2 E 19 to a Hickory at the branch, thence up said branch 46 chains
