South Carolina Know all men by these
 Greenville District presents That I George
 Green of Greenville District and State aforesaid
 and in consideration of the natural love and affection

which I have and bear to my son Hembo Green of said district in the State aforesaid
 and also in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to me in hand paid by the said
 Hembo Green of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold
 and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Hembo
 Green All that tract or plantation of land being a part of a Tract of land originally
 granted Henry Benson, containing one Hundred and Sixty one acres, more or less situated
 lying and being in the district of Greenville aforesaid lying on both sides of Cereus river
 beginning at a maple corner on the South West side of said River and running thence
 N 57 W 12.34 to a Black oak bush thence N 45 W 12.77 to a Post oak. Thence N
 30 1/4 E 15.28 to a Black oak Thence N 63 E 39.25 to a Hickory & Thence S 30 E 32.80
 to a Stone Thence S 80 W 32.18 to a pine Thence 88 1/2 W 17.50 to a Birch on the North
 E side of said river Thence down and up and across said river to the beginning corner and
 to the same shape marks and form as is represented by a plat of the same surveyed by W
 Q Street doct de. Vincente attached and dated the 24th day of February 1844 bounded by
 lands of the said George Green Aldridge Green Herring and Harkins, Ephraim Suber
 and William Cunningham

To Have with all and singular the rights, Members
 Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises, belonging in anywise incident
 or appertaining To Have and to hold, all and singular as the Premises before
 mentioned unto the said Hembo Green his Heirs and assigns forever

And I do truly bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Adminors
 to warrant and forever defend, all and singular as the said Premises to the said Hembo
 Green his Heirs and assigns against me and my Heirs, and against whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
