Beginning on an ash 3X on said creek, running Thence N 25 E 8.00 to Stake 3X Thence N 50 E 44.00 to a Stake 3X Bounding on John Gambrell and Elizabeth Gains lands Thence S 40 E 24.00 to a Stake 3X on said Sullivans' Land Thence down the meander of a Branch 8.00 to a maple 3X Thence up the meander of a fork of said branch 12.00 to a maple 3X Thence S 50 W 62.00 to a Dogwood 3X on Pine creek bounding on Archy Petersons' land Thence up the meander of said creek to the beginning
