



of One Hundred and Twenty nine dollars to me in hand by Ethel Holsclaw of Greenville District and State aforesaid the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Ethel Holsclaw and to her heirs and assigns forever all their and each of their rights titles and Interest estate claim and demands both at Law and Equity and as well in possession and Appurtenance of in and to all that certain farm a piece of land that was owned by the above named Hannah Vaughn at the time of her death Situate in Greenville District in Bushy Creek waters of Conoco River containing One Hundred acres more or less and hath such boundaries whereas beginning on a Stake corner of an ash 37 cm in James Wards branch down branch to Bushy Creek running down said creek to John Wests line thence along said line to a post oak in the field, thence along the original line to the beginning on the branch it being a part of a Tract of land originally granted to Isaac Morgan all that Tract, dividing the premises Together also another tract or parcel of land containing five acres lying on said waters bounded on the East side of the above described tract of land and hath such boundaries, whereas beginning on a stake on Rivers line on a branch from thence down said branch to a stake corner on Rivers line along said line to Wests Spring Branch to a stake thence said branch to a post oak from thence a straight line to the beginning it being a part of a Tract of land originally granted to Allen Kemp and Paul Abner, grants bearing date January the 5th 1785 and January the 5th 1795 in the whole One Hundred and five acres more or less with all and singular the Incumbrances and Appurtenances, Thence belonging
