and thence with her land until it strikes Robert Pitmans land and thence
with said Pitmans land to the beginning, the being part of a tract of land
granted to the said Joseph Barton. Together with all and singular the rights
members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises and I do
truly bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to quiet claim to the
