fence on Robert Pitman line to a chestnut Thence to a small bush still
on Robert Pitman land Thence to a Spanish oak William Pitman line Thence
along a line of marked trees to a cedar fence on James Gosnell line Thence
along said fence until it strikes Pleasant Barons line Thence with the said Bar-
on to the beginning corner
