 James Emory Hopkins and John Lewis Hopkins and their heirs forever upon
 the Terms, Trusts, uses, and Conditions hereinafter specified To wit to have
 and to hold the said Slaves, Maria and Willis in trust for my daughter Mary-
 reth Ramsey for and during the term of her natural life and at her death in
 trust for the heirs of her body To have and to hold the said Slaves Kuldah
 and Sam in trust for my daughter Ann Baker for and during the term
 of her natural life and at her death in trust for the heirs of her body
 To have and to hold the said Slaves Susan and Tom in trust for my daug-
 hter Mary Caroline Hopkins for and during the term of her natural life
 and at her death in trust for the heirs of her body and To have and to
 hold the Slaves Harriet and See aforesaid in trust for my daughter Louisa
 Hopkins for and during the term of her natural life and at her death in trust
 for the heirs of her body and in the event that either of my said daughters shall
 die without leaving heirs of her body, then the slaves held in trust for such
