



E. of the Prusky Creek Fork, being a branch of the Fork Thence down said branch to the point of the Buzzard Ridge Thence up said ridge to the back line of the old tract Thence along said line to the Beginning containing by estimation One Hundred and Thirty Acres be the same more or less.
