


John Henson Deed State of South Carolina Known all men
 To 111 Greenville District by these presents
 John Henson Esq. Dees That John Henson Son of the State and District
 aforesaid in consideration of Five Thousand Dollars
 to me paid by John Henson Son in the District aforesaid have granted bargained sold
 and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 John Henson Son all that Tract or parcel of Land Containing One hundred and
 eleven acres more or less Situated in Greenville District on Side of the
 River Beginning on a maple on the Middle side of the river James Henson on
 nor Thence S 82 E 5 rods to a Spanish oak Thence N 25 E 17 ch 75 Links to a
 white oak Thence S 34 E 25 ch 58 to a Stake James Henson corner on the East
 Miller line Thence S 23 W 24 ch 20 L to Black oak Thence N 80 W 21 ch 50 L
 to a chestnut Thence N 12 E 3 rods to a small Hickory on the bank of the River Then
 down the River with its several meanders to the beginning Being a part of a tract
 of Land granted to Allen Cowan Together with all and singular the rights mem-
 bers hereditaments and appurtenances belonging to the same or in any wise incident
 or appertaining to it To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said John Henson for his heirs and assigns forever And I
 do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John
 Henson for his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
