Also two tracts or parcels of Land Situated lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on the Abbeys on road near Saluda River one of said tracts containing One Hundred and fifty Acres more or less purchased of Ann Satterfield the other piece or parcels containing Sixty Three Acres more or less and purchased of the said Ann Satterfield To have and to hold all and singular the said premises in several possessions for the proper use and purposes hereinafter mentioned to wit in Trust for the sole use benefit and enjoyment of me the said Sarah Satterfield for and during my natural life and after my death to wit the death of the said Sarah Satterfield to her children share and share alike and the said Sarah Satterfield do hereby also give in Trust to the said William Canble a certain negro woman called Risetta and her two children To wit Mary and Frank and the future increase of said female slaves to hold them in Trust for the sole and separate benefit of the said Sarah Satterfield during her natural life and at her death for the sole and separate benefit of the children of the said Sarah Satterfield And the said property both real and personal is conveyed on this condition among others that the said Trustee shall have power and is hereby empowered to sell and convey the aforesaid property or any of it

Shall be it be to the advantage and benefit of the said Trustee to do so and the money or other property obtained for the trust property shall be held and subject to the same limitations as the original property herein named

And I do hereby warrant the title of the said Lands and of the said negroes unto the Trustee aforesaid for the use and purpose therein specified
