Sullivan of the District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the Love and affection which I have for my son John Q. Sullivan as well as one dollar in hand paid me by the said John Q. Sullivan The receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge as well as Two Thousand Dollars which I have charged against him on my book kept against my children as part of his Leg- -acy out of my estate. have given, granted bargained and released and by these presents do give, grant, bargain and release unto the said John Q. Sullivan his heirs and assigns three parcels or tracts of Land, containing in all Six hundred and Eighteen and eight Acres situated and lying in Greenville District, described as follows One Tract formerly belong to John Evans, containing one hundred and ninety seven acres more or less or being part of a Tract originally granted to Francis Cotton in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four on the sixteenth day of July Witness His Excellency Benj ^{ne} Guerard, situated lying in the Dist- -rict and State aforesaid on the bottom Green Creek waters of Saluda beginning on an ash corner on W. H. Evans line running thence N 58 E 1/2 to a Post oak corner thence N 6 W 28.50 to a Mulberry corner on the little Green creek, thence up said creek 31 chains to where the original line crossed said creek 37 thence on said line to an ash corner on a little branch 17 chains, thence up said branch S 2 E 52 to W. H. Evans line 37 thence on said line to a Black Oak corner at the head of a branch thence down said branch to the beginning corner A second Tract formerly belong to Charles Garrison containing Four hundred and twenty acres, situated and lying in the District and State aforesaid near the mouth of Golden Green Creek adjoining lands of Samuel Williams, W.
