 part of the Tract of Land containing Ninety Acres being and being situated
 in the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina on the waters of Camp Creek the
 waters of the South River being the undivided but distributive share of John Parrell
 as well as more fully appear to Her Honor John Parrell to myself recorded in Clerk's Office
 of Greenville District County of Sanders of George Pitt, David Jackson and others con-
 taining Five hundred Acres more or less

Therefore with all and singular the Rights Members Privileges and
 advantages to me in the part of the said premises belonging as in any way in-
 ident or appertaining to them and to hold all and singular the premises herein men-
 tioned unto the said Massey A. Jackson his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself
 my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and give a deed all and singular
 the said interest unto the said Massey A. Jackson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs
 and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
 part thereof With this my hand and seal this 18th day of October 1850 and in the County of
 the Independence of the U. S. A
